This show contains film stills from my thirteen channel video project, The Lovers, which premiered at LUMP in Raleigh, NC in 2018. This show is also punctuated with images from my photogram series Swan Song, which premiered at The Ackland Art Museum in Chapel Hill, NC in 2017.

The title of the show is borrowed from the Anthropologist Loren Eiseley from his essay on Halley's Comet. He writes: "What will await me is not pleasant, but it is in the star's destiny as well as mine. I lie awake once more on the dark bed. I feel my heart beating, and wait for the hurrying light."

My view is slightly more optimistic. I feel we can learn from ourselves and push forward into a more enlightened age where we carefully consider our presence inside of the larger context of nature and its cycles.

In this work, I am considering light as a material and as a reference to time. This show reconsiders these frozen images in a new context of an artist living in quarantine during our global pandemic.


