As an educator, Leo is a faculty member at Sotheby's Institute of Art and the V&A Academy, where he leads courses in art business and fine art. He co-authored and illustrated the book Contemporary Figures in Watercolor (Batsford 2021) and has contributed to many publications including Portraits for NHS Heros (Bloomsbury 2021) and Decentralized Please Save Culture (New Society 2023). He has been featured on national television in the UK and Brazil, including the televised series Portrait Artist of the Year (UK, 2020).
